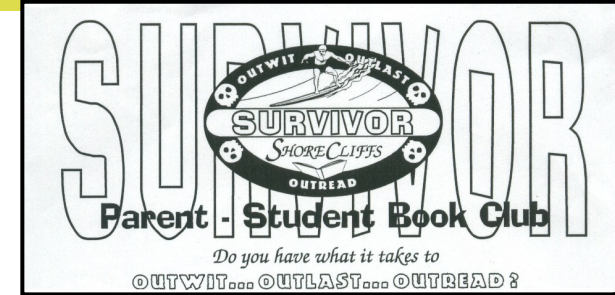

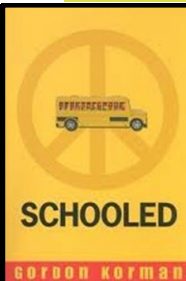

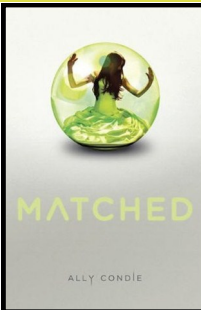


Schooled

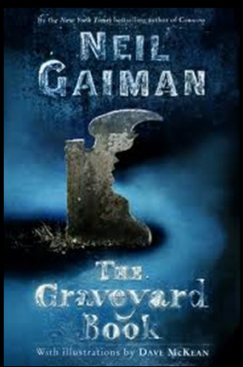
